**Multilateral Special Agreement RID 3/2025
under section 1.5.1 of RID
concerning the carriage of metal alloys in massive form
containing lead assigned to UN No. 3077**

- (1) This agreement shall apply only to metal alloys assigned to UN 3077 Environmentally hazardous substance, solid, n.o.s., packing group III in accordance with 2.2.9.1.10.6 as a consequence of 2.2.9.1.10.5, containing:
 - (a) $\geq 0.25\%$ of lead massive (particle diameter ≥ 1 mm);
 - (b) $\geq 0.025\%$ of lead powder (particle diameter < 1 mm).
- (2) The requirements of RID shall not apply to the carriage of metal alloys in accordance with paragraph (1) provided that the following conditions are met:
 - (a) They do not fulfil the criteria of any class other than RID Class 9.
 - (b) The metal alloys are sparingly soluble in water.
 - (c) The metal alloys are carried:
 - (i) in packagings that are sift-proof and water-resistant or are fitted with a sift-proof and water-resistant liner; or
 - (ii) in bulk in sheeted or closed wagons, containers or bulk containers.
- (3) This agreement shall be valid until 31 August 2027 for carriage in the territories of those RID Contracting States signatory to this Agreement. If it is revoked before then by one of the signatories, it shall remain valid until the abovementioned date only for carriage on the territories of those RID Contracting States signatory to this Agreement which have not revoked it.
